Belleville, ON - The City of Belleville's Recreation, Culture & Community Services Department kicked off the Yardmen Arena Expansion and Renovation Project in November 2016 with an anticipated completion date of November 2017. The Department and Ball Construction are working together to minimize impacts to clients visiting the Quinte Sports & Wellness Centre, however, adjustments to traffic patterns and parking will be required throughout the project.

Ball Construction has begun their work on the north west sides of the Yardmen Arena. Construction fencing has now been erected and starting today, Thursday, January 5, 2017, the north west entrance off 265 Cannifton Road will be closed to all vehicular traffic, except for construction vehicles and use as an emergency exit. Clients are asked to use the south west entrance off 265 Cannifton Road to access the Quinte Sports & Wellness Centre until further notice.
